Swimming Standards 2020 - 2021 Statement

This statement records the swimming standards achieved by Year 6 children at the end of the 2020-2021 academic year.

There are three swimming outcomes, which children achieve by the time they leave St Peter's Catholic Primary School.

These are:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively, for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke.
- Perform safe self-rescue in different water based situations.

Due to COVID 19 restrictions we were not able to follow our usual programme but offered intensive swimming during the Summer Term 2021 and will continue to do so. As a result data is unreliable so we have reported opportunities that were provided rather than outcomes. Next academic year we will report in the usual way.

Percentage of students who had the opportunity to swim 25m using a variety of strokes and performed a self-water rescue.	100%
Percentage of students who had the opportunity to swim confidently over a distance of 25 metres	100%
Percentage of students that had the opportunity to swim 25metres using a variety of strokes	100%
