Please note: Children in Year 2 will be given a homework folder in which to file their homework. This will be kept in school. Children should hand in their named homework on Monday mornings.

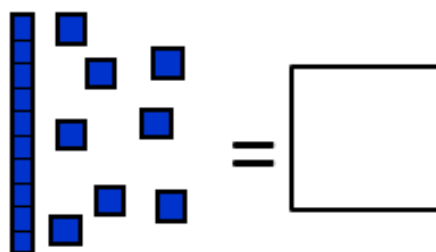
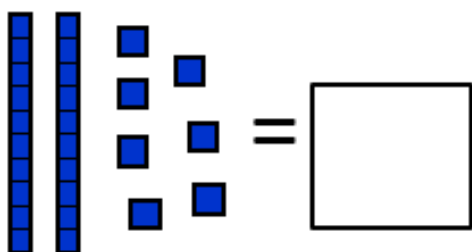
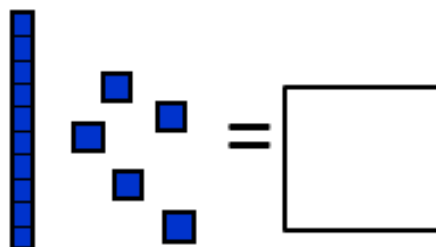
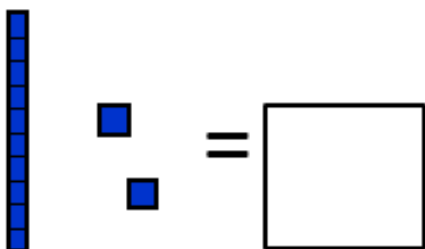
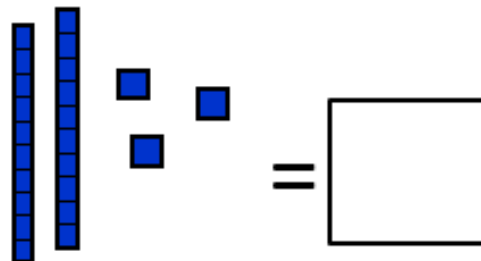
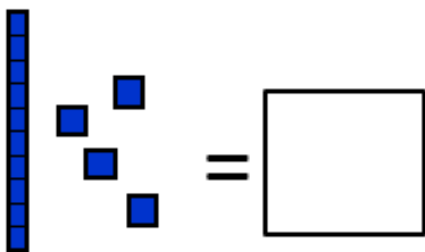
